Charles Payraudeau THE NATURALIST FROM LA CHAIZELE-VICOMTE

Born in 1798 in La Réorthe, **Benjamin Charles Payraudeau** grew up in La Chaize-le-Vicomte. After studying at the Lycée Napoléon in La Roche-sur-Yon, he joined the **National Museum of Natural History** in Paris, where he developed a passion for ornithology and zoology.

Between 1824 and 1825, during an expedition to Corsica, Payraudeau cataloged the local wildlife and discovered several previously unknown species, including two iconic birds: **Audouin's Gull** and **Desmarest's Shag**.

His collection, enriched throughout his life, was bequeathed to the municipality of La Chaize-le-Vicomte in 1868.

After years of neglect, it was restored and relocated to its current site on May 9, 1994.

This unique collection is now preserved and exhibited to the public at the Charles Payraudeau Ornithological Museum.
